Some vehicles just aren't suited for car seat use, while other times we can make adjustments to the vehicle and/or select certain car seats to improve compatibility. And, naturally, when multiple car seats are used in one vehicle, fit can become a problem, even in vehicles that aren't considered tiny. We'll learn about general tips and explore some specific examples.
