

Booster Seats? We Don't Need No Stinking Booster Seats

Terry will cover a little of the history of booster seats and talk about how they have changed. He'll discuss misuse and why parents transition so soon, or don't use boosters at all.

Neonatal Nurses' Knowledge and Provision of CPS Information: An Assessment

Heidi Heflin, SafetyBeltSafe U.S.A. carseatrn@gmail.net

Nurses are a CPS resource during the neonatal period. Nursing literature on CPS is deficient. Heidi will review a study assessing nurses' knowledge and its use to keep newborns safe when traveling in motor vehicles. Heidi will present the results of an anonymous survey that was distributed to members of the National Association of Neonatal Nurses showing less than one-half of respondents answering scenario and knowledge-based questions correctly, yet admitting they address CPS during hospitalization through car seat tolerance screenings and caregiver education.
